Mahara is Cranfield University's ePortfolio system. It is used to share your work with your facilitator and to track your progress.

Example POEMS Workspace in Mahara

Instructions:

1. Go to your POEMS Workspace in Mahara
2. Download and complete your first/next activity sheet, saving it to your computer.
3. Edit the activity block, inputting how long the activity took you
4. Upload your completed activity sheet to the **Attachments** area

(The above is to be completed for each activity sheet.)

You will see that the activity sheets have been split into 3 activity blocks. Once you have completed an activity block you are to fill in the reflection box and submit the entire page to your facilitator's group. Your feedback will appear in the **POEMS Workspace** Feedback section below.




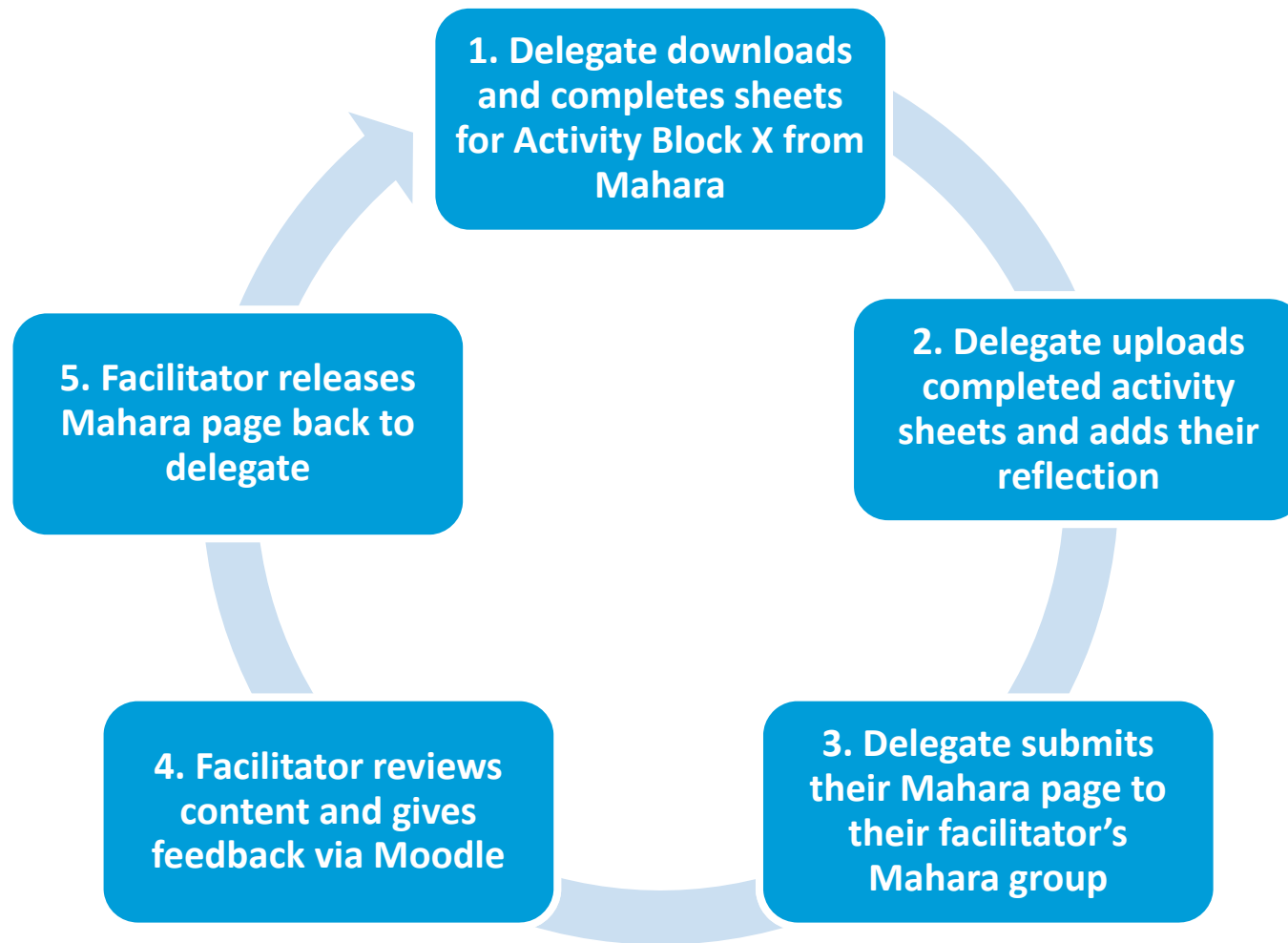

“By using a combination of Moodle and Mahara we have **defined spaces** for delegate and facilitator, making the delegate portfolios **clear and simple** for external examiners to follow, and allowing facilitators to easily look up and trace **delegate progress** through the database facility.”

FEEDBACK FROM DR. LADYMAN

“I would like to get rid of the **anecdotal style** of evidence in favour of **‘real’ evidence** such as videos, and make the Mahara pages more than just an upload space by allowing the delegates more **flexibility**. I am also keen on introducing more pre-course work through **interactive activities on-line** which integrate with face to face workshops on-course.”

WHAT NEXT?

- Gather feedback from delegates, facilitators and assessors after the first year of implementation
- **Moodle:**
 - Badges and/or certificates for quiz assessment, course attendance and online activity completion
- **Mahara:**
 - Move to a more visual portfolio rather than file repository (i.e. no more document dumps)
 - Create a SmartEvidence IEMA framework to map skills
